

Regaining the consensus of commitment

- Seek perspective and advice from your consultant, coach, etc.
- Leaders should first “look in the mirror.”
- Form a “company of the committed.”
- Discipline serious commission sinners (if applicable), and remove uncommitted people from roles of leadership (if applicable).
- Challenge chronically ommissive individuals (privately or together) with humility and appropriate firmness.
- Create new “privileged” structures that require commitment.
- Launch a preaching offensive on this subject in your home group meetings.
- Be patient and persistent—this is a battle that won’t be won overnight.
